





Jedem Das Seine, Tito is a live visual concert unfolding as a journey across Europe in search of the abandoned ruins of our era. It expands and reimagines Tito.fragments, a project created in 2019 that investigated our contemporary moment - thirty years after the fall of the Berlin Wall through an exploration of the recent ruins left behind by humanity.

The events of 1989 are portrayed as they were triumphantly broadcast by televisions worldwide - heralded as the end of history, the moment when the West's mission was fulfilled and, from a regional power, it became the representative of all humanity. JEDEM DAS SEINE, TITO is a modular, site-specific, and ever-evolving project. It explores themes surrounding the culmination of the historical process and the ruins of our era, continuously reshaping itself to suit the unique narrative and spatial context of each performance.

Lavinia, daughter of General Tito, is violated in a cruel act of rebellion against her father, her hands and tongue severed to silence her voice forever. Through the eyes of this young prophetess, haunted and powerless to alter the course of history, we traverse a century marked by the atrocities of war and the darkening horizons of our present time.

The concert-performance transforms the space into a fragile, immersive wall on the brink of collapse, a living canvas where sound and visuals conjure the echoes of horror and memory etched deep within our recent past.

This work draws its breath from Cubo's pilgrimage through the ruins of our era, journeying through Berlin, Teufelsberg, Beelitz, Weimar, Buchenwald, Dresden, Stare Jarozowice, Warsaw, and Inowlodz—places where history's scars remain visible.
